SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP: Every camper must be a member of the Boys & Girls Club of North Lake Tahoe. All Inclusive Memberships are \$100 for Kindergarteners, \$100 for 1st-6th graders and \$100 for teens (7th - 12th) grades. All Inclusive Memberships, which include before school programs, after school programs, minimum days and breaks (does not include summer fees), are valid from July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019. Please fill out a membership form online or at the front desk.

WEEKLY DAY CAMP FEE: The weekly day camp fee for Kinder - 6th graders is \$70. Specialty camp fees vary, see specialty camp page for more details.

DROP IN DAYS: "Drop ins" are allowed for Kinder - 6th graders for a \$25 daily fee. Please sign up at the front desk the day of.

FIELD TRIPS: Campers must purchase and wear a BGCNLT Club shirt on field trips for identification purposes. Shirts are \$10 and available online and at the front desk. Shirts available for pickup on June 11th.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be issued only if a field trip or specialty camp is canceled.

BEACH DAYS: Every Friday, campers will walk to "Safeway Beach" in Kings Beach leaving at 10:30 am and returning at 2:30 pm. Please send your child with a swimsuit on under their clothes, a towel, beach gear and make sure to apply sunscreen!

SCHOLARSHIPS: We offer discounted fees to qualifying families. Applicants must fill out a scholarship form and provide 1) Proof of gross monthly household income 2) A list of all household members 3) A list of all major monthly bills and amounts. Please pick up a scholarship packet at the front desk if interested.

TRANSPORTATION FROM TRUCKEE: Transportation is available for campers who live in Truckee. For more information and to reserve a seat sign up online or at the front desk. Purchase a full summer bus pass for \$150 or pay \$25 per week.

IMPORTANT FACTS TO REMEMBER:

- In order to sign up for a field trip, you must be enrolled in the week of summer day camp or a drop in day.
- Campers participating in specialty camps can stay for the whole day. They will join day campers when their sessions end.
- Campers must wear sneakers except on beach days and water related field trips.
- Bikes, scooters and skateboards are allowed but must be locked up and brought home each day. Riding is only allowed during designated times throughout the day and helmets are required. BGCNLT is not responsible for stolen or damaged personal items.
- The Club closes at 6:00 pm each night. A fee will be charged to families who are late to pick up their campers.


